

LORE Overview

What is LORE?

LORE is a practitioner-centered learning academy that equips public sector leaders with the skills to *transform internal* operational practices which inhibit an organization's ability to function equitably, effectively, and efficiently.



Program Structure



Two Session Structure

- Fall Session: September December
 - Focus: communication & decision-making
- Spring Session: February May
 - Focus: project implementation & process change

Format

- Cohort-based peer learning community
- Monthly in-person workshops on the second Wednesday of every month from 9am-12pm at NIU Naperville campus
- 1-2 hrs online interactive learning per month

Who Should Apply?





Participant Teams

- Minimum of 2 participants (max 4)
- 1 participant must be an exec or senior-level (City Manager/Assistant City Manager/Dept Head)



Organizational Commitment

- Cross-functional team approach
- Leadership support for project implementation



Cost & Time Commitment

- Tuition
 - \$3,500 for first two participants
 - \$1,500 for each additional participant
- Time ~4-5 hrs/month
 - 3 hrs in-person workshop
 - 1-2 hrs online readings and assignments


