EdPolicy Lab spans Chicago's geographic and racial spectrum. Our schools range from predominantly Black and Latino communities on the South and West Sides to more affluent, majority-White North Side neighborhoods. Student populations reflect that range—from 98% Black at Ariel to 67% Latinx at Alcott, with more mixed populations at schools like Westinghouse.

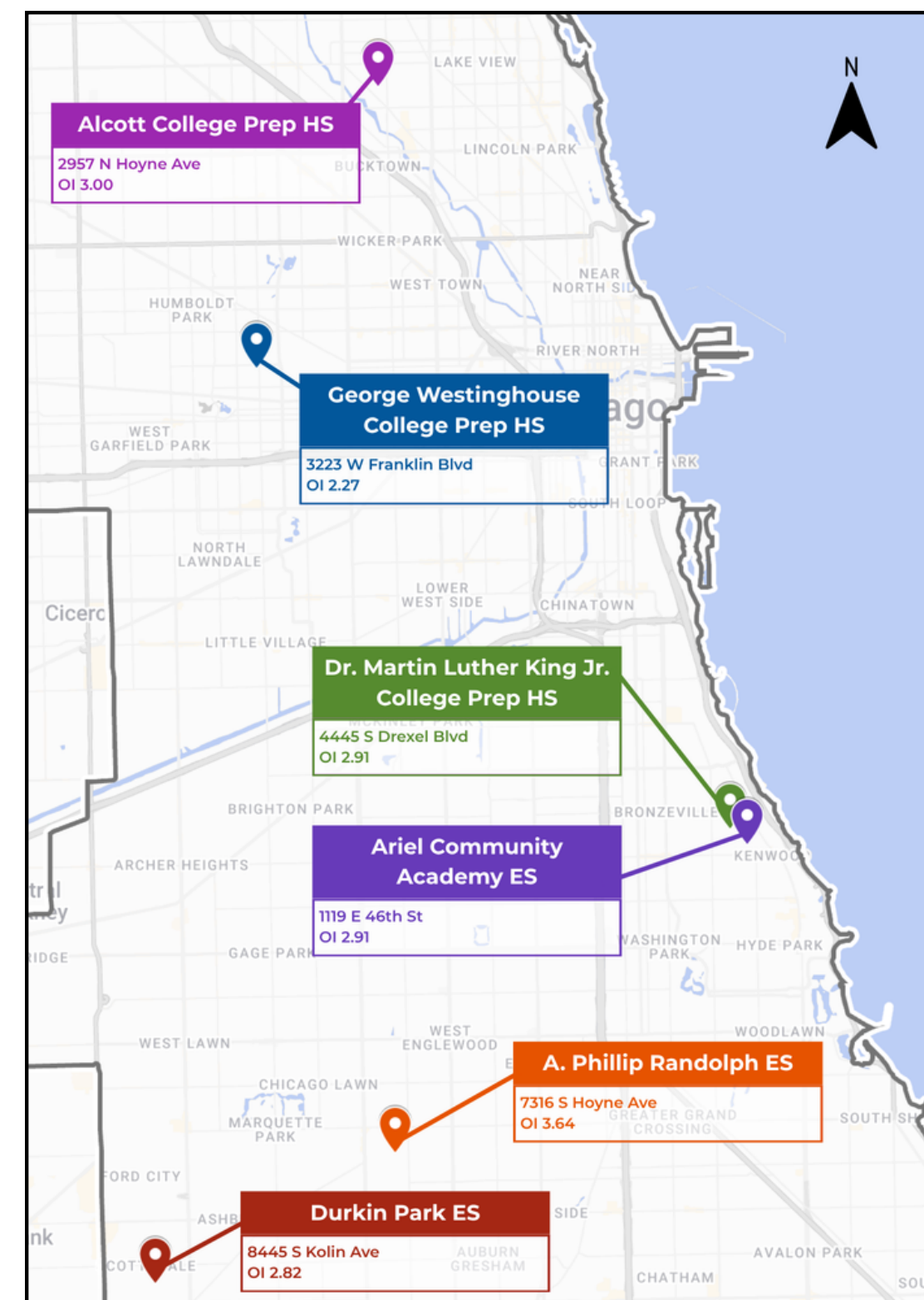
